Guidelines for Abstract Submission

The first author of an abstract will be the presenter of this contribution at the Psychology Research Symposium. As first author, each person may submit a maximum of two submissions.

These can be either:

1. ORAL PRESENTATION

Presentation time is 10 minutes with an additional 5 minutes for Q & A. Individual oral presentations will be grouped into coherent sessions. Each session will be moderated.

2. VIRTUAL POSTER

Presenters of Virtual Poster will be presenting their research in parallel sessions. Each 15-minute session features 3-5 posters on a common theme. Participants with accepted Virtual Poster have to send their virtual poster (.pdf) by 1st March 2021 to psysunway@gmail.com. The virtual poster will be posted on the website two days date before the event. Symposium attendees will be able to preview the poster on the website before attending the scheduled poster sessions.

3. THREE-MINUTE PITCH (3MP)

Presenters of Three-Minute Pitch (3MP) provides audience with one static PowerPoint slide to explain their research in 3 minutes (180 secs). The presentation could be on empirical research, innovative practice, and/or theoretical advances.

Regardless of submission type, every presenter is required to submit an abstract. The Scientific Committee will review all abstracts and feedback will be given for each submission. In some cases, abstracts for oral presentations and poster may be switched if the content is deemed more appropriate for a specific form or to fit the balanced of poster and oral presentations in the programme.

Submission could be submitted based on any of the subthemes below:

- Clinical Psychology
- Health Psychology
- Cognitive Psychology
- Educational Psychology
- Developmental Psychology
- Industrial-Organizational Psychology
- Personality Psychology
- Cyber Psychology



 - Type of submission
 - Subthemes
 - Purpose
 - Methodology
 - Results
 - Limitations
 - Implications
 - Research Impact


